## White House Caravan and Camping Site

## **Accessibility Statement**

We are fully committed to being disability friendly at White House Camping and Caravan Site.

The site is situated on a level field adjacent to the River Wye.

A level 130m well lit road, part tarmacadam, part tarred gravel, leaves the A470 trunk road and leads to the site.

Access to the town of Builth Wells (approx. 300 metres) is by street pavement with appropriate dropped kerbs for wheelchair access.

Pitches are grass or hard standing, with space for awnings on hard standing or grass surfaces.

Parking besides your caravan or tent is allowed.

Internal roads have grass or well compacted hard core surfaces.

A modern toilet block has a dedicated room (2.2m x 2.5m) with a 80cm wide outward facing door. Facilities include the usual toilet and hand basin plus a wheelchair accessible shower. Grab rails are fitted throughout this room.

Water points, chemical toilet disposal and dustbin areas are no further than 60m from any pitch.

All pitches are accessible by car.

Local bus services pass the site entrance & local taxis service the park.

Mobile telephone reception is good and there is also a coin operated telephone box approximately 300m from the site entrance.

Although we have tried to be as accurate as possible and include as much detail as we can in this statement, we are always willing to give information on any aspect of the park, if this statement does not answer your particular question.
